Dear Friends at ~~Cleveland~~ Park,

As Rev Sarah is on holiday at the time of writing, she has asked me to write this month's Letter from the Minister. So, for this month, you have a Letter from the Superintendent!

Following our Holiday Club, I've continued to reflect on the Micah memory verse. This verse shaped both Holiday Club and our Gathered Circuit Worship on 16th August.

"... what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:8)

Our Heroes in Training explored these words alongside stories about the Disciples James and John, known as the 'Sons of Thunder'. Together, they helped us think about what it means to seek justice in the world around us: acting fairly, being kind, and looking after one another and the world. We had a great week!

I loved that, on our final day, the children shared the qualities they thought God's Superheroes should have:

kind, generous, brave, kind to ourselves, fantastic, thoughtful, good, kind with our words and actions, good listeners, truthful, fearless, gentle, and smiling!

What I loved about these words and phrases is that the children came up with them without our help, and they echoed the verses from Micah that we had been reflecting on together. And reminded me again that these verses are not just words to be preached on, but words to be lived out!

As God's Superheroes, and as we head into a new ~~Connexional~~ year, let's live out what the Lord requires of each of us: to act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with God.
